Use: Lacromin is recombinant human lactoferrin that is completely animal component free. Human Lactoferrin is present in serum, milk and colostrum, and has growth promoting activities in mammalian cell culture. Lactoferrin can also supply iron, similar to transferrin, in certain cell culture applications. For cell culture applications, Lactoferrin can be used as a growth factor and the iron saturated form (Holo) is recommended. Lacromin is an iron saturated form (Holo) of recombinant human lactoferrin and has been designed specifically for cell culture applications and research.
